



CLINICAL CASE SUBMISSION

Submissions are invited for clinical cases relevant to the field of functional urology as part of the 1st Functional Urology International Course Training. All contributions must be written in English and should present original material that has not been previously published or presented at other scientific meetings.

Authors are required to ensure that all submitted cases are fully anonymized. No patient identifiers should be included, and the main document must not contain any information that could reveal the identity of the authors, their institutions, or affiliations. Compliance with applicable ethical standards is expected, and patient consent should be obtained whenever required according to local regulations.

The submission window will open on May 20 and close on June 15, 2026 (inclusive). Submissions received after the deadline will not be considered. Authors are encouraged to adhere strictly to the provided template and formatting requirements, with a maximum length of 800 words. Contributions should be clear, well-structured, and focused on clinically relevant aspects of functional urology.

In order to ensure scientific neutrality, the use of commercial product names is not permitted. Authors should refer exclusively to generic names and avoid any form of promotional or industry-biased language.

All submissions will undergo a selection process based on their scientific relevance, originality, and educational value, as well as the clarity and organization of the presentation. Particular attention will be given to cases that highlight clinical reasoning, decision-making processes, and practical implications for everyday practice.

Only authors who are registered participants of the course will be eligible to present their cases. Therefore, at least one author of each accepted submission must complete course registration in order for the case to be included in the final program.

Authors will be notified regarding the outcome of the selection process by 3 July 2026. Detailed instructions for presentation will be provided upon acceptance.
